Teams will design and construct an educational display suitable for use at a fair or community event. The display should highlight the importance of the maple industry in Pennsylvania by providing accurate, engaging, and easy-to-understand information for the public. Displays should include a balance of educational content (such as the process of maple syrup production, the history of maple in Pennsylvania, or the benefits of supporting local producers) and interactive or visual elements that capture attention.

Your display should:

• Educate the Public

 Include accurate information about maple syrup production, history, and/or benefits of supporting local producers.

Promote a Local Maple Weekend

 Feature a flyer, banner, or creative element encouraging attendance at a local Maple Weekend event.

• Engage the Audience

o Incorporate an interactive or hands-on element

Show Visual Appeal

 Use props, posters, models, or decorations to attract attention and make the booth look fair-ready.

Be Presented as a Fair Booth

- o Prepare to present your display as though you are talking with visitors at a fair.
- Every team member should take part in the explanation.
- Exhibits may not exceed 40 inches deep by 8 feet wide and may not be over 8 feet tall from the floor. Exhibits must be constructed and set up so that they will not blow over or be easily knocked over (Dimensions were taken from the Agriculture Education/FFA Window Exhibits Rules).
