How do Scholar Dollars Work?



Three people sign up to work the Pennsylvania FFA concession booth on behalf of their chosen FFA Chapter.



Each person works for three hours earning \$12 an hour on behalf of their FFA Chapter.



At the end of the event, the selected FFA Chapter receives a check for \$108 from the Pennsylvania FFA Foundation for the work of the three volunteers.
